Academy members have opportunity to submit research grant proposals for Academy funding, receive the Academy's 100+ year peer-reviewed journal entitled the *Proceedings* of the Indiana Academy of Science, receive continued education through lecture, workshops and hot topics presented at the members Annual Academy Meetings; interact with and mentor young future scientists from Indiana high schools; are invited to participate in community science education events and scientific research, receive the Academy's quarterly newsletter filled with information about upcoming Bioblitz and other events, open positions available in the state of Indiana and the country; and so much more.

The Indiana Academy of Science has been an important voice of Indiana science since its inception in 1885. It continues to enjoy a high professional stature with a membership that includes many of the states' premier scientists and science educators. - **Sustaining Member:** This membership category provides the opportunity for individuals to be recognized for an additional degree of support to the Academy and its work. Sustaining members receive all the rights and benefits of Members in addition to special recognition for support.
- **Student Member:** This membership category is for graduate and undergraduate college students. Student membership is entitled to Academy newsletters, discounts and announcements. The *Proceedings* of the Indiana Academy of Science is not included in the student membership.
- **Life Member:** This membership is available to any member of the Academy in good standing. Life members receive the *Proceedings*, newsletters, discounts and announcements.
- **Emeritus Member:** This level of membership is available to individuals who are at least 65 years of age, are retired, and have been active members of the Academy for 15 years or more. Emeritus status is conferred by the Council.
